Since 1877, the Australian Sheep and Wool Show (Sheep Show) has been showcasing Australia's top wool growers and prime lamb producers and now attracts thousands of fans of woollen fashion, food and fibre.

The Sheep Show features the 'best of best' sheep breeders, shearers and wool handlers in the country. More

than 5000 farmers, the best fleeces in the country and 28 different breeds of sheep, goats and alpacas make their way to Bendigo each year for the Sheep Show.

One of the Farmers taking out a variety of Awards at this years show was Jeff Sutton, winning The Australian Supreme Interbreed Long Wool group, The Oakes trophy for best group of four border Leicester sheep, Grand Champion Ram and Junior champion Ram.

Jeff said Bendigo's success come from years of hard work and dedication and also from the success he had in Sydney, winning the supreme prime lamb sire at the Sydney Royal Easter Show.

"I wasn't disappointed at all, our hard work defiantly paid off" He said.

Jeff will be holding his Inaugural Property Ram sale on the 14th September, with 20 stud ewes, 8 stud rams and 70 flock rams all for sale.
